Before you begin work, **please contact the O. G. office**. The staff has decades of practical experience regarding maintenance and construction in a coastal environment. They can advise you whether you need approval for your project and other helpful information whether you are a new or long term owner.

MODIFICATION REQUEST and PERMISSION and PERMITS

The office will provide you a "Modification Request Form", (if needed). Fill out the form and return it to the General Manager, Sherri. The General Manager (GM) will review the application. Depending on the owner's renovation work there are various outcomes listed below. Be sure to contact the office in advance.

1: <u>Some</u> work can be done without permission from your condo assoc or from the ARC (Architectural Review Committee). The office can advise you.

2: The General Manager (GM) will send a complete request to the ARC. Depending on the type of request and completeness the ARC can do a formal review meeting, may ask for additional information, or may approve without a formal meeting. The ARC checks that Ocean Gallery (OG) alteration standards are met and that the condo association grants permission when applicable.

3: Interior work <u>may</u> require condo association permission and must meet condo rules.

4: Exterior work <u>may</u> require permission from the ARC (Architectural Review Committee)

5: In some instances, approval from both your Condominium Association and the (ARC) (Architectural Review Committee). are needed.

6: St Johns County (SJC) may require building permits. (This is the responsibility of the owner and their contractor to comply with SJC permit requirements.)

WHY IS PERMISSION NECESSARY?

Florida Condominium associations are governed by laws first created in 1963. Condo associations create governing documents to maintain property values and the quality of the neighborhood. Your condo board and ARC are responsible for maintaining the quality of the neighborhood.

Condo owners own everything within the interior condo walls. Every condo owner has an "undivided" interest in property outside of their condo. This is the "common elements" that is owned by your association and use of the "common elements" is governed by your condo board, governing documents, and condo law.
